

# Guideline on Use of Professional Titles (For All Categories)

### **PART ONE - INTRODUCTION**

#### Purpose

This guideline aims to establish a clear and consistent standard for the use of professional titles by members of the Association. Its primary purpose is to ensure accurate and professional representation of our members and the sports therapy profession to the public.

Consistent application of professional titles enhances credibility, promotes public trust, and strengthens the collective identity of sports therapy professionals. This guideline applies to all forms of communication, including but not limited to:

- Presentations
- Promotional materials (both online and print)
- Business cards
- Websites and social media profiles
- Correspondence

#### Scope

This guideline is applicable to all members of the Association, regardless of their specific area of practice within sports therapy. It covers the appropriate use of designated professional titles, abbreviations, and any other relevant credentials.

#### **Key Objectives**

The objectives of this guideline are to:

- Promote a unified and professional image of the Association and its members.
- Ensure accurate representation of professional qualifications and expertise.
- Prevent misuse or misrepresentation of professional titles.
- Enhance public understanding and recognition of the sports therapy profession.
